

ORDINANCE NO. 478

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ANIMALS AND FOWL WITHIN THE VILLAGE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY AND TO REPEAL PRIOR ORDINANCES; TO REQUIRE FILINGS; AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA; that

SECTION 1. Prohibited Animals and Fowl.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain within the corporate limits any horse, mule, sheep, cow, goat, swine or other livestock.**
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain within the corporate limits any poultry, chickens, turkey, geese or any other fowl.**

Penalty. See ss. 10.99. Statutory reference Neb. N.R.S. 17-547.

SECTION 2. The above-referenced prohibition against animals and fowl shall be kept in the ordinance book, Title 17, and labeled Section 93.02-100.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or sections or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
