## **ORDINANCE #525**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SNOW REMOVAL ON SIDEWALKS ON MAIN STREET IN SECTION 92.50 OF THE NEBRASKA BASIC CODE, AS ADOPTED BY THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY; TO PROHIBIT MOVING SNOW FROM LOTS, DRIVEWAYS OR SIDEWALKS ONTO THE STREETS AFTER SNOW HAS BEEN CLEARED FROM THE STREETS BY AGENTS OF THE VILLAGE; TO REPEAL ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; TO PRESCRIBE THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA, that:

## **SIDEWALKS**

**SECTION 1. 92.50 – REQUIREMENT TO KEEP CLEAN.** 

It shall be unlawful for the occupant of any lot or lots or the owner of any vacant lot or lots within the corporate limits to allow snow, sleet, mud, ice, or other substance to accumulate on the sidewalks or to permit any snow, sleet, ice, mud, or other substance to remain upon the sidewalk.

The Board of Trustees provides that all sidewalks within the business district shall be cleaned within five (5) hours after the cessation of a storm. If the storm or fall of snow shall have taken place during the night, and the business owner chooses to push the snow from the sidewalk onto Main Street, the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 6:30 a.m. Sidewalks within the residential areas of the Village shall be cleaned within twenty-four (24) hours after the cessation of the storm. No person shall move the snow from lots, driveways or sidewalks, owned or controlled by them, onto the streets after snow has been cleared from the streets by agents of the Village. Once a street has been cleared it shall be unlawful for persons to move snow into street traffic lanes or street parking lanes.
