

ORDINANCE NO. 526

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A VILLAGE SALES AND USE TAX OF ONE PERCENT (1.0%); TO REPEAL ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; TO PRESCRIBE THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA that:

Section 1. At a duly publicized general election held on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2018, in which all qualified electors were entitled to vote, the majority of votes cast at said general election were in favor of a one percent (1%) sales and use tax for the Village of Ansley.

Section 2. Pursuant to the general election results and the Local Option Sales Tax Revenue Act, there is hereby imposed in the Village of Ansley, Custer County, Nebraska, a sales and use tax of one percent (1%) upon the same transactions within the Village of Ansley on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a sales and use tax, the revenue of which shall be used for the purpose of providing funds to pay the cost of various capital improvements for streets, parks, swimming pool, light, water, and sewer, including debt incurred for said improvements; excluding wages, insurance and equipment; and the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, shall increase its total restricted funds authority by \$40,000.00 (18%) over the current year's total restricted funds authority.

Section 3. Said sales and use tax shall be imposed and become effective on April 1, 2019, as provided by law.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
