ORDINANCE NO. 534

An ordinance of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, establishing rates for the solid waste collection and disposal service of said Village; establishing fees for use of and defining acceptable materials to be disposed of in the compost site; repealing any ordinance, parts of ordinances, or policies in conflict with this ordinance; and to prescribe the time when this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA that:

Section 1. SOLID WASTE RATES. Each occupied household and active commercial operation shall pay the established fees for solid waste disposal service.

The rates to be paid by **residential** customers shall be as follows:

- (1) For each household ------\$18.00 per month
- (2) For an additional tote or similar container (must be compatible with Village tote tipper) (no more than two totes per residence)--- \$18.00 per month
- (3) For rental fee on tote ------ \$ 5.00 per month on newer style totes
- (4) For out of system (rural) residential users-\$18.00 per month

 Rental fees for totes will not be applied towards purchase of the tote.

There will be an additional \$5.00 charge for any and each item outside the container.

The rates to be paid by **commercial** customers shall be as follows:

- (1) For each commercial customer ----- \$34.00 per month
- (2) For each commercial customer
 - requesting a second pickup ----- \$20.00 per container
- (3) For rental fee on dumpster ------ \$10.00 per month

Rental fees for dumpsters will not be applied towards purchase of the dumpster.

Containers in residential areas will be picked up once each week. Commercial customers will receive weekly service unless a more frequent pickup is agreed upon.

The rate to be paid by residential or commercial customers for the temporary use of an additional dumpster shall be as follows:

- (1) \$15.00 per yard
- (2) \$20.00 per yard for shingles

Bills for solid waste collection and disposal and the compost site shall be rendered and collected monthly on the Village's utility bill.

Section 2. COMPOST SITE RATES. There will be a .50 cent fee per month for each residence for access to use the compost site. This fee will also apply to commercial operations with a need for disposal in the compost site. This fee covers disposal of the following acceptable items at the site:

- (1) grass clippings
- (2) leaves and small branches
- (3) garden produce
- (4) untreated lumber

(5) dog and cat waste (removed from plastic or other containers)

For complete or substantial removal of a tree(s) for a resident by either a resident or commercial contractor, there will be a \$10.00 fee per load for a straight truck or smaller vehicle for disposal in the compost site. The fee for large dump truck/end dump will be \$20.00 per load; side dump or longer end dump will be \$30.00 per load.

Fees for non-residents will be \$20.00 per load for a pickup or trailer or small straight truck; large end dump trucks will be \$25.00 per load; side dump or longer end dump trucks will be \$35.00 per load.

Section 3. That any policy, ordinance, or parts thereof of the Village of Ansley in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That the rates established in this ordinance shall take effect with the bills rendered due September 1, 2019.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form within 15 days from this date and also by posting a written copy in each of three public places in the Village, to-wit: the Flatwater Bank, the Village Clerk's Office, and the United States Post Office.
