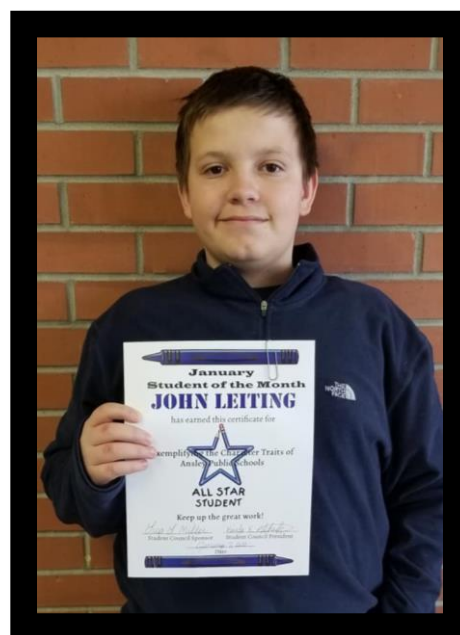

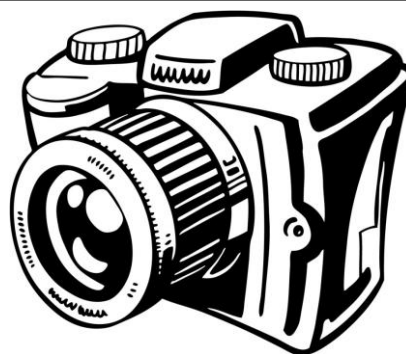

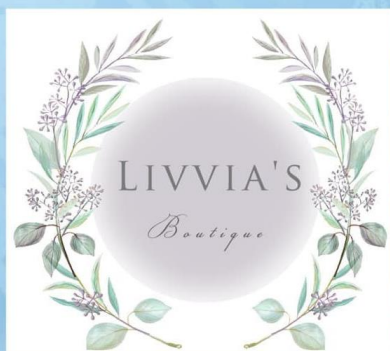

ST. LOUIS BBQ RIBS

DIFFICULTY 3/5

PREP TIME 20 MINS

COOK TIME 4 HRS

SERVES 4-6

HARDWOOD PECAN

INGREDIENTS

2 RACKS ST. LOUIS BONE IN PORK RIBS

6 OZ TRAEGER PORK & POULTRY RUB

8 OZ APPLE JUICE

1 BOTTLE TRAEGER SWEET & HEAT BBQ SAUCE

PREPARATION

Trim ribs and peel off membrane from the back of ribs.

Apply an even coat of rub to the front and back of ribs.

Let sit for 20 minutes and up to 4 hours if refrigerated.

When ready to cook, set temperature to 225°F and preheat, lid closed for 15 minutes.

Place ribs bone side down on grill grate. Put apple juice in a spray bottle and evenly spray ribs. Smoke for 1 hour.

After 1 hour, remove ribs from grill and wrap them in aluminum foil. Leave an opening at one end, pour in remainder of apple juice (about 6 oz) into the foil and wrap tightly.

Place ribs back on grill, meat side down and smoke for an additional 3 hours.

After 3 hours, start checking the internal temperature of ribs. Ribs are done when the internal temperature reaches 203°F.

When ribs are done, remove from the foil and brush a light layer of sauce on the front and back on the ribs. Return to the grill and cook an additional 10 minutes to set the sauce.

After sauce has set, take ribs off the grill and let rest for 10 minutes.

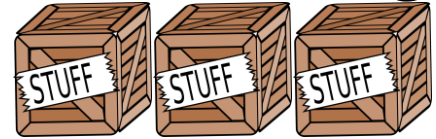
To serve, slice ribs in between the bones. Enjoy!

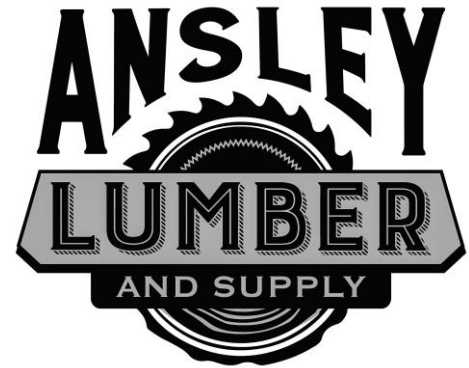

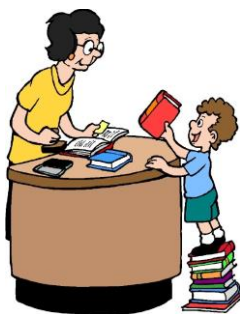

History of Custer County, Nebraska: Ansley's Professional Men

ANSLEY'S DRUG STORES

The first druggist was Sam Royds, who was also postmaster. He came in 1886 and, upon his death, in 1888, his wife (now Mrs. B. J. Tierney), succeeded him. She conducted the business until it was sold to Charles H. F. Steinmeir, in 1906. Mr. Steinmeir now conducts a Rexall store and the value of his enterprise is estimated at \$40,000. The second drug store in Ansley was that of Rev. Walter Theobald, a Baptist minister, and it was opened Shortly after that of Royds. This store was later disposed of to Charles B. Hare and was run by him for a number of years—until his death, in September, 1905, when the stock was sold to C. H. F. Steinmeir. **Continued.....**

Shortly after the death of Royds, his clerk, O. P. Allphin, opened a drug store, and he continued in business until 1912, when the stock was disposed of to Dr. E. A. Hanna. Hanna, in turn, disposed of it, October, 1917, to Charles Chandler, who now conducts one of the best pharmacies in the state. The value of his investment is \$15,000.
