ULTIMATE SMOKED TURKEY

DIFFICULTY **3/5**

PREP TIME **24 HRS**

COOK TIME **4 HRS**

SERVES **6-8**

HARDWOOD **APPLE**

INGREDIENTS

1 (18-20 LB) TURKEY

1 TRAEGER TURKEY BRINE KIT

1/2 CUP TRAEGER PORK & POULTRY RUB

1/2 LB SOFTENED BUTTER



PREPARATION

The day before, brine the turkey according to the Traeger Turkey Brine Kit package directions. Remove from brine, rinse and pat dry. Season the inside cavity with Traeger Pork & Poultry Rub. Prepare the turkey by separating the skin from the breast creating a pocket to stuff the softened butter in. Cover the entire breast with 1/4-inch thickness of butter.

Transfer to the fridge and let chill for at least 1 hour.

Remove from the fridge and truss the legs and tuck the wing tips back around the bird.

When ready to cook, set the Traeger to 225°F and preheat, lid closed for 15 minutes.

Place the turkey in a roasting pan and place directly on the grill grate. Cook until the internal temperature reaches 100-110°F.

Increase the temperature on the grill to 350°F and continue to cook until an instant read thermometer registers 160°F when inserted in the thickest part of the breast, about 3 to 4 hours total cook time. Turkey will continue to cook once taken off grill to reach a final temperature of 165°F in the breast.

Remove the bird from the grill and let rest for at least 15 minutes before carving. Enjoy!

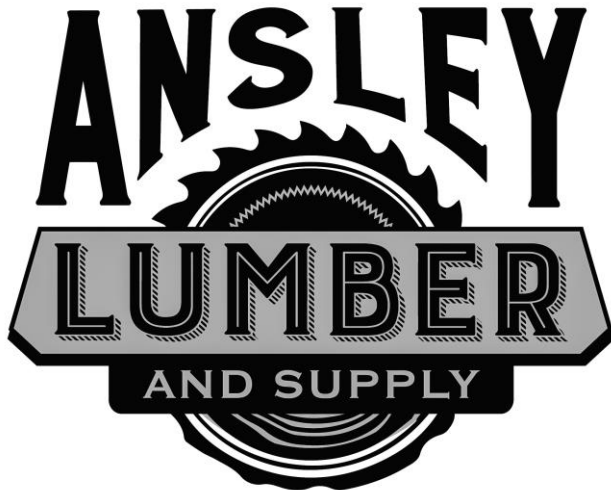

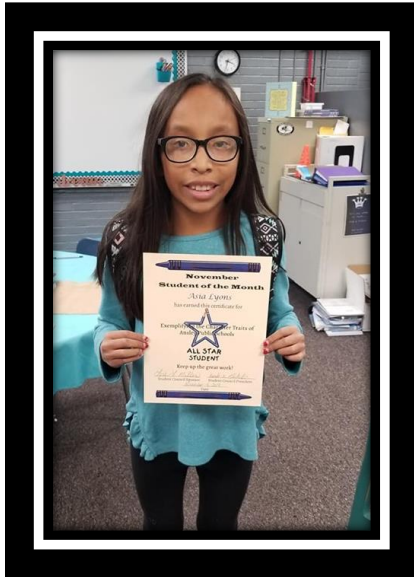

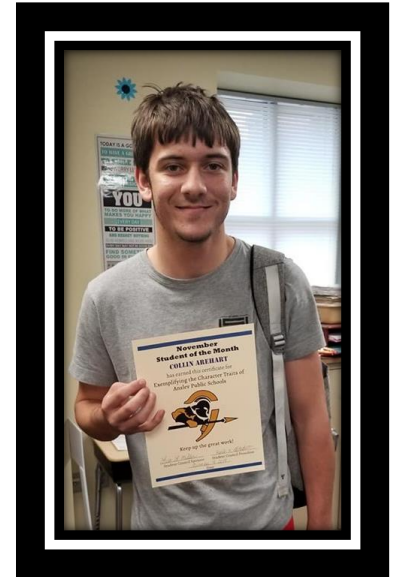
