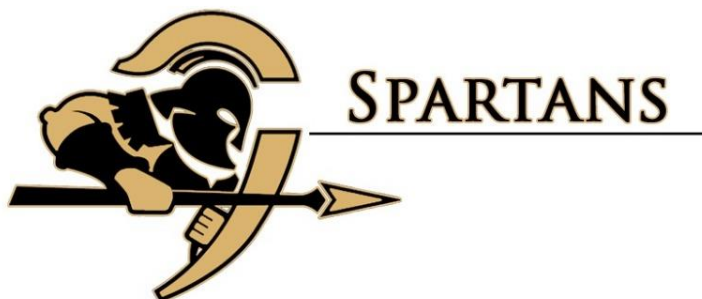
Federal Universal Service Charge Notice

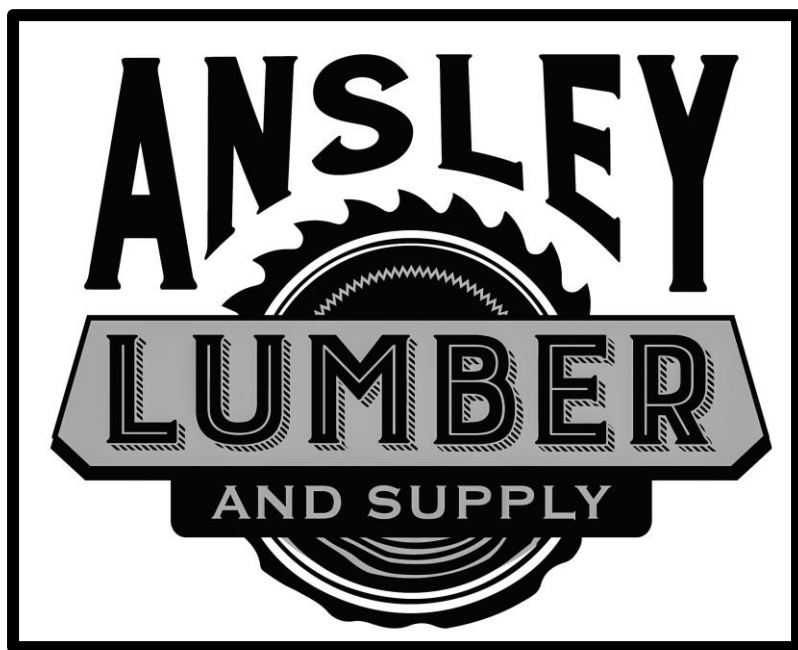
