#### NATIONAL MINT JULEP DAY



National Mint Julep Day on May 30th each year sets up a refreshing toast to summer. Each year, people around the country gather for a glass of mint julep! This refreshing southern classic is a traditional drink of the Kentucky Derby.

A classic mint julep is made with a mint leaf, bourbon, sugar, and water. In the Southern states, where mint julep is more associated with the cuisine, spearmint is the mint of choice. Preparation of the drink may vary from one bartender to another.

Some believe the mint julep originated in the southern United States sometime during the 18th century.

The term "julep" is generally defined as a sweet drink, particularly one used as a vehicle for medicine. During the 19th century, Americans also enjoyed a gin-based julep.

Each year, Churchill Downs serves almost 120,000 mint juleps over the two-day period of the Kentucky Oaks and the Kentucky Derby.

May 2008 - Churchill Downs unveiled the world's largest mint julep glass (6-foot tall).

#### **GRILLED PEACH MINT JULEP**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 Peaches, fresh
- 2 Ounce bourbon
- 1 Cup sugar
- 1 Cup water
- 2 Tablespoon Peppercorns, pink
- 10 Pieces Mint, fresh leaves
- As Needed ice
- 1 Lime Wedge

#### **STEPS**

To make the whiskey peaches, cut a peach into slices. Soak peach slices in bourbon in the refrigerator for 4-6 hrs.

For the Pink Peppercorn Simple Syrup: In a shallow pan, combine 1 cup sugar, 1 cup water, and 2 Tbsp of pink peppercorns. When ready to cook, set grill temperature to 180°F and preheat, lid closed for 15 minutes. For optimal flavor, use Super Smoke if available.

Cook syrup down on the smoke setting for 30 minutes, or until desired smoke flavor has been reached.

For the Grilled Whiskey Peaches: When ready to cook, increase the grill temperature to 350°F and preheat. Place the whiskey peach slices directly on the grill grate and cook 10-12 minutes or until peaches soften and get grill marks. To make the Julep: Muddle 1/2 oz Pink Peppercorn Simple Syrup with 10 fresh mint leaves, and 4 slices of grilled whiskey peaches. Add crushed ice over the rim of the glass. Pour bourbon over the crushed



ice and stir. Garnish with 1 large sprig of

mint and fresh lime. Enjoy!





#### **UPDATE TO ANSLEY RESIDENTS:**

The Village has received a grant for GIS mapping of our water system. This will provide very detailed mapping of water mains, curb stops, shut offs, water valves, meter pits, fire hydrants etc. with the capability of showing additions and changes to the system well into the future. The project must be completed and paid for by the end of this calendar year before the Village is eligible for reimbursement with the grant funds.

Utility Superintendent Bill Moser has completed the area north of Main Street from the railroad tracks east, and will soon start marking locations on the south side of Main Street from the railroad tracks east with pink flags and pink paint.

When this second quadrant is completed our engineering firm Miller & Associates of Kearney will come in with a drone to record all the locations in that quadrant for the permanent mapping system.

The NW quadrant of Ansley which included everything from Valley Street south to Main Street and from Division Street east to Adrian Street has been completed so residents in that area can now remove the pink flags. FOR RESIDENTS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF MAIN STREET PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE PINK FLAGS MARKING LOCATIONS ON OR NEAR YOUR PROPERTY!

We realize mowing season has started, but once the Engineers have been in and recorded everything in the south side quadrant, we will provide an update that area has been completed and Bill will move to the final area. The Village will really appreciate your cooperation of leaving the flags in place to avoid doubling the work by having to remark. 
