## ORDINANCE NO. 415

An ordinance of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, to amend Section 3-711 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, 1981 and 1986; to provide when bills for electrical service are delinquent; to provide for notice to consumers of delinquent electrical bills and for demand for payment thereof; to provide for a reconnection fee for the resumption of electrical service after electrical service has been disconnected; to repeal original Section 3-711 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, 1981 and 1986, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance; and to prescribe the time when this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 3-711 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, 1981 and 1986 be amended to read as follows:

§3-711 MUNICIPAL ELECTRICAL SYSTEM; DELINQUENT ELECTRICAL BILLS; RECONNECTION FEE. Electrical fees shall be due and payable monthly at the office of the Municipal Clerk. If said fees are not paid within ten (10) days after the same become due, such fees shall be deemed to be delinquent. Upon being deemed to be delinquent, as herein defined, the Municipal Clerk shall give a written notice to the consumer of such delinquency and shall demand payment immediately. In the event the bill is not paid within seven (7) days after the sending of said notice, it shall be discretionary with the Municipal Clerk to continue disconnection procedures in compliance with Section 3-801. Before service shall be resumed after disconnection the consumer shall pay a reconnection fee of \$25.00, and said payment shall be made to the Municipal Clerk or other person designated by the Governing Body.

Section 2. That original Section 3-711 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, 1981 and 1986, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances which have been heretofore passed and approved by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
