ORDINANCE NO. 419

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING PARTICIPATION BY THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY IN THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (CREATING THE PUBLIC ALLIANCE for COMMUNITY ENERGY); AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE EXECUTION OF SAID AGREEMENT: TO PRESCRIBE THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA, That:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby finds and declares that energy, both electricity and natural gas, is an indispensable commercial commodity and it is in the public interest and in the interest of the energy consumers of the Village that the Village enter into an Interlocal Agreement relating, among other things, to energy acquisition and supply, which Interlocal Agreement creates the PUBLIC ALLIANCE for COMMUNITY ENERGY ("PACE"), a nonprofit body politic and corporate of the State of Nebraska, as authorized by and in accordance with Section 18 of Article XV of the Constitution of the State of Nebraska and the Interlocal Cooperation Act of the State of Nebraska, §§13-801 et seq., R.R.S. Nebraska, 1943, as amended.

Section 2. The formation of **PACE**, and the participation by the Village therein, is hereby approved.

Section 3. It is hereby ordered and directed that the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, acting through its Chairperson and Village Clerk, execute the Interlocal Agreement, a copy of said Agreement being attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4. The Village of Ansley, Nebraska does hereby adopt and approve each of the objectives, terms and conditions set forth in the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 5. The Village of Ansley, Nebraska does hereby agree that the Village will accept delivery of full legal and unencumbered title to the assets, if any, of PACE, upon the dissolution thereof in accordance with the terms of the Interlocal Agreement.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
