

ORDINANCE NO. 423

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES; TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF UNREGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES UPON ANY STREET, ALLEY, OR PUBLIC HIGHWAY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISMISSAL OF A COMPLAINT ALLEGING THE OFFENSE OF FAILING TO PROPERLY REGISTER A MOTOR VEHICLE IF THE OWNER PROPERLY REGISTERS SUCH VEHICLE, PAYS ALL TAXES AND FEES DUE, AND PROVIDES PROOF OF SUCH REGISTRATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Chapter 5, Article 1, Section 114, of the Municipal Code of Ansley, Nebraska be amended to read as follows:


REGISTRATION; OPERATOR AND VEHICLE LICENSE. (1) No person shall operate or park a motor vehicle upon any street, alley, or public highway within the Municipality without having first registered the same in accordance with Chapter 60, Article 3, RS Neb., except as provided in this subsection. A person may operate a motor vehicle without registration for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of purchase. Upon registration, such vehicle shall have the required number plates displayed upon said vehicle in the manner and places provided for by section 60-323 RS Neb. If a citation is issued to an owner of a vehicle for a violation of this subsection and the owner, within ten (10) days of issuance of the citation, properly registers and licenses the vehicle not in compliance, pays all taxes and fees due, and provides proof of such registration to the prosecuting attorney, no prosecution for the offense cited shall occur.

(2) No person shall operate a motor vehicle upon any street, alley, or public highway without having obtained a motor vehicle operator's license in accordance with Chapter 60, Article 4, RS Neb. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle upon any street, alley, or public highway during the period that his or her operator's license has been revoked or canceled. Section 2. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
