

ORDINANCE NO. 432

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE DISCHARGE OF EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS; TO PROVIDE FOR NOTICE AS REQUIRED BY LAW; TO CHANGE THE TIMELINE FOR OBTAINING A BLASTING PERMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. That Chapter 7, Article 3, Section 302, of the Municipal Code of Ansley, Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

EXPLOSIVES; BLASTING PERMITS. In addition to notifying the Municipal Fire Department pursuant to section 28-1233(3) RS Neb., any person desiring to discharge explosive materials, as defined in section 28-1213 RS Neb., within the Municipality, shall apply for and secure a permit from the Governing Body twenty-four (24) hours prior to such discharge, and shall discharge such explosive materials in conformance with the conditions specified in the permit. In no case shall any person perform blasting operations unless operating under the direct supervision of a person in possession of a valid user's permit issued by the Nebraska State Patrol. Section 2. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
