

ORDINANCE NO. 433

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE STORAGE OF POISONOUS AND FLAMMABLE GASES AND EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS; TO PROVIDE FOR NOTICE AS REQUIRED BY LAW; TO CHANGE THE TIMELINE FOR STORAGE REGISTRATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. That Chapter 7, Article 3, Section 301, of the Municipal Code of Ansley, Nebraska be amended to read as follows:

POISONOUS AND FLAMMABLE GASES AND EXPLOSIVES; STORAGE REGISTRATION. In addition to notifying the Municipal Fire Department pursuant to section 28-1233(3) RS Neb., any person desiring to store or keep for any period of time explosive materials as defined in section 28-1213 RS Neb., or any form of poisonous or flammable gases or liquefied petroleum gases within the Municipality shall register such information with the Municipal Clerk twenty-four (24) hours prior to such storage. The transfer of such explosives or gases to another person within the Municipality shall require the person receiving such explosives or gases to register the transfer and the new location of the explosives and gases with the Municipal Clerk. The transfer of explosive materials and gases to a new location by the owner shall require registration of the new location with the Municipal Clerk. This section shall not apply to the storage of five (5) gallons or less of gasoline. (Ref. 17-549, 17-556, 28-1229, 28-1233 RS Neb.)


Section 2. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.
