Ordinance No. 441

An ordinance of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, to name an unnamed street running east and west in the Village from the intersection of said street and Cameron Street east to the intersection of said street and Belmont Street; to provide for the marking of said street with the name hereby given to the street; to fix the time when this ordinance shall take effect; and to provide for the manner for publication of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The unnamed street in the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, running east and west between the intersection of Cameron Street and the unnamed street and to the intersection of the unnamed street and Belmont Street is hereby named "South School Street". Street signs with the same or similar design as existing street signs shall be erected to appropriately mark said street.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and by posting a written copy in each of three public places in the Village.
