

ORDINANCE NO. 504

An ordinance to revise and establish a schedule of rates for the use of the sanitary sewer system of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, and for hook-up charges to the system in order to accumulate money for the maintenance and operation of the sanitary sewer system of the Village, to repeal Ordinance No. 491 and all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance, and to prescribe the time when this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSLEY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. In order to create a fund of the village for maintenance and operation of a sanitary sewer system of the village a schedule of rates for use of the sanitary sewer system of the village and for hook-up charges to the system shall be as follows, to-wit:

- (a) For each customer who occupies a building as a residence or part of a building as a residence, and each customer who occupies a building for a commercial or business purpose, or part of a building for a commercial or business purpose, the sum of \$33.50 per month.
- (b) For the School District of Ansley, Nebraska, the sum of \$125.00 per month. For Ansley Housing Authority, the sum of \$210.00 per month. For Custer's Last Stop the sum of \$90.00 per month.
- (c) Customers who desire to hook up to the sanitary sewer system shall pay hook-up fees as follows:
  - (1) All owners shall pay a hook-up fee of \$150.00

The charges herein provided for shall be due and payable the 1<sup>st</sup> day of each month following the use of the system by the customer and shall be delinquent ten days thereafter, and when delinquent shall be charged and paid at the daily rate computed at the rate of 9% per annum.

The rate schedule shall be effective with the bills due and payable on March 1, 2015.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 491 of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska and all ordinances of said Village or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting as required by law.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form within 15 days from this date and also by posting a written copy in each of three public places in the Village, to-wit: the Security State Bank, the Village Clerk's Office, and the United States Post Office.
