

**VILLAGE OF ANSLEY**  
**Special Meeting**  
**April 21, 2025 – 6:30 p.m.**  
**Municipal Auditorium**

A special meeting of the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska was held in the Municipal Auditorium on Monday, April 21, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. Present were Chairperson Rehfeld; Trustees Schulte and Mills. Trustee Henry entered the meeting at 6:38 p.m. Trustee Hogg was absent. Also present were Crystal Murrish, Melissa Schulte and Michelle Nelson.

Notice of this meeting was posted in three (3) public places, the Clerk's Office, Flatwater Bank and the Ansley Post Office as required by law. Notice was also posted on the Village website and Facebook page. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance thereof to the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings shown hereafter were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public. Chairperson Rehfeld opened the meeting at 6:30 p.m.; verified compliance with the open meeting act; Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Discussion regarding the swimming pool season 2025 included talk about how many applications were received, what the pool season might look like, wages, expectations and maintenance for the pool. We have a total of 7 applications and the board would like to hire all 7 applicants. Trustee Schulte moved to hire Marissa Campbell and Emmitt Hintz as Pool Managers at the rate of \$15/hour; Clysta Brott as Assistant Manager at the rate of \$14.25/hour; and lifeguards Garittee Smith at the rate of \$13.75/hour and Wyatt Hoblyn-Shoemaker, Jaycee Vogel, and Kaleb Aguilar at the rate of \$13.50/hour for the 2025 season. Trustee Henry seconded the motion and on roll call vote, the following Trustees voted AYE: Schulte, Henry, Mills, Rehfeld; ABSENT: Hogg; motion carried.

Further discussion included how individuals will be contacted. Chairperson Rehfeld asked if Michelle would be in contact with the individuals since she will be the person in contact with them throughout the summer. The need to fix the gate into the baby pool is urgently needed. Trustee Henry moved to fix the gate to the baby pool up to the amount of \$350.00 with anything beyond that amount needing approval from the board. Trustee Schulte seconded the motion and on roll call vote, the following Trustees voted AYE: Henry, Schulte, Mills, Rehfeld; ABSENT: Hogg; motion carried.

Trustee Schulte will contact Patriotic Fencing and see if they can look at the gate and give a quote for the work.


Melissa Schulte asked about the existing basketball hoop that was there. She thought that it might be broken and would like to see about getting a replacement using funds from possibly the Square Pegs Improvement or some other way to get this done. Losing the high board will have an effect on some kids and to be able to replace with other things in the short term, would be helpful. She will continue to look into this option. Michelle is going to check and see if the hoop is still there and if it is broken or still in working form.

Regarding the pool and mowing this summer, there needs to be clear expectations that the mowing around the pool needs to be done before noon and to mow away from the pool to keep the grass clippings out of the pool. Chairperson Rehfeld will visit with Todd to discuss this with Christina and anyone that will be mowing this year.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Chairperson Rehfeld adjourned the meeting at 7:17 p.m.
