VILLAGE OF ANSLEY Special Meeting September 24, 2025 – 7:30 p.m.

A special meeting of the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of the Village of Ansley, Nebraska, was held in the Village Clerk's Office on Wednesday, September 24, 2025, at 7:30 p.m. Present were Chairperson Scott Rehfeld and Trustees Joel Schulte, Chris Hogg, and Rob Henry. Absent was Trustee Vas. Also present, Lanette Doane and Michelle Nelson.

Notice of this meeting was by posting in three (3) public places, the Clerk's Office, Flatwater Bank and the Ansley Post Office as required by law. Notice was also posted on the Village website and Facebook Page. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance thereof to the Chairperson and Board of Trustees of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the public. Chairperson Rehfeld opened the meeting at 7:33 p.m.; the Pledge of Allegiance was recited; compliance with the open meeting act was verified.

Chairperson Rehfeld opened the public hearing on the proposed Village budget at 7:34 p.m. to receive testimony, support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the proposed budget. In depth discussion and review of the budget with Lanette reminding the Board that they must watch the income and expense report more closely than the budget document itself. Our valuation increased from last year. After review and discussion of the proposed budget, Chairperson Rehfeld closed the public hearing at 8:12 p.m.

Trustee Hogg moved to approve and adopt the 2025-2026 Village budget as published. Trustee Henry seconded the motion and on roll call vote, the following Trustees voted AYE: Hogg, Henry, Schulte, Rehfeld; ABSENT: Vas; motion carried.

ORDINANCE PASSAGE PROCEEDINGS UNDER SUSPENSION OF RULES Village of Ansley, Nebraska

Trustee Hogg introduced Ordinance No. 562 entitled:

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE BUDGET STATEMENT TO BE TERMED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL; TO APPROPRIATE SUMS FOR NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

and moved that the statutory rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended. Trustee Henry seconded the motion to suspend the rules and upon roll call vote on the motion the following Trustees voted AYE: Hogg, Henry, Schulte, Rehfeld. ABSENT: Vas. The following voted NAY: None. The motion to suspend the rules was adopted by three-fourths of the Board and the statutory rule was declared suspended for consideration of said ordinance.

Said ordinance was then read by title and thereafter Trustee Hogg moved for final passage of the ordinance, which motion was seconded by Trustee Henry. The Chairperson then stated the question was "Shall Ordinance No. 562 be passed and adopted?" Upon roll call vote, the following Trustees voted AYE: Hogg, Henry, Schulte, Rehfeld. ABSENT: Vas. The following voted NAY: None.

The passage and adoption of said ordinance having been concurred in by a majority of all members of the Board, the Chairperson declared the ordinance adopted, and the Chairperson in the presence of the Board signed and approved the ordinance, and the Clerk attested the passage and approval of the same and affixed her signature thereto. The ordinance is to be filed in the Village of Ansley Ordinance Record Book as a permanent record thereof.

Chairperson Rehfeld opened the public hearing to set the final tax levy request for FY 2025-2026 at 8:15 p.m. for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers. Discussion commenced and the changes from the Legislation was reviewed.

Trustee Schulte introduced Resolution No. 04-2025 and moved its adoption.

RESOLUTION 04-2025 SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provides that the Governing Body of the Village of Ansley passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the City or Village of Ansley resolves that:

1. The 2025-2026 property tax request be set at:

General Fund: \$144,958.29

- 2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 9.49 percent.
- 3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property would be 0.455634 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 4. The Village of Ansley proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 0.5 per \$100 of assessed value.
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the Village of Ansley will increase last year's budget by 6.46 percent.
- 6. A copy of this resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2025.

Adopted this 24th day of September 2025, at Ansley, Nebraska.
